I have reasons to suspect that my teen is drinking or using drugs.

I don't know what to do...

What can I do to be a more effective parent?

In this class, you will learn effective and positive skills to address problem behaviors, provide active supervision and learn warning signs of mental illness, drug and alcohol use, and other risky behaviors.

Note: Participants must attend all 10 sessions. After finishing the course parents will receive a certificate of completion.
